## Study in Taiwan Book Project

### Project Goal:

The purpose of this project is to write and publish a special handbook on studying in Taiwan for Mongolian students who are intending to study in Taiwan. The book will cover various topics including Taiwan and its culture, history and natural environment, Taiwanese higher education system and educational opportunities for international students. The book will be the primary suitcase book for Mongolian students who wish to learn about everything about studying and succeeding at a Taiwanese university. As the number of Mongolian students in Taiwan increase each year, it has become necessary to provide a comprehensive handbook for current and future students.

The book will consist of the following chapters:

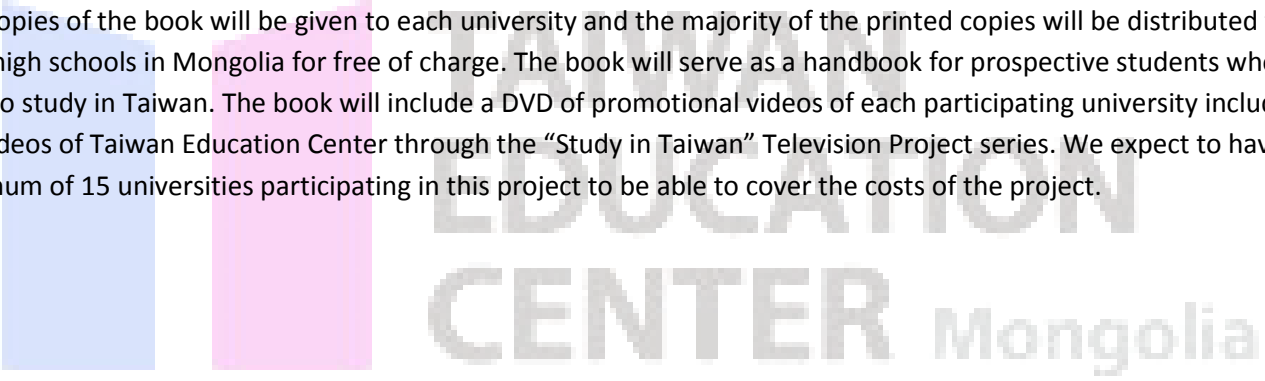
1. About Taiwan: “Taiwan Miracle” and its secrets to becoming an Asian tiger with a high tech and knowledge driven economy
2. Taiwanese higher education system: Accreditation and university ranking and differences of public and private universities and how to choose the right college for yourself
3. Financing Your Education in Taiwan: Secrets to winning scholarships, conditions of scholarships and testimonials from current former government and institutional scholarship recipients, online resources for searching for scholarships etc.
4. Applying for a university in Taiwan: Secrets to preparing a winning admission documents to a Taiwanese university including how to fill out your application forms, write up your statement of purpose, cover letter, recommendation letters, CV and resume, financial declaration, letter of invitation and etc. Actual samples will be provided to make it useable.
5. Preparing your language proficiency: This section will talk about various tests including HSK, TOCFL and TOEFL and secrets to preparation for language test requirements.
6. Immigration Matters: This section will talk about various types of visas and the conditions and requirements of a student visa in Taiwan. Tips will be given on how to apply for your student visa, maintain your status and change types and any other related but necessary information on immigration in Taiwan.
7. Succeeding in Taiwan as a student: This section will cover various topics on student life at a university in Taiwan including university environment and culture, culture shock and adaptation, transportation, money management, employment, and social life.
8. Student stories: We will collect stories from students who are studying in Taiwan or graduates of Taiwanese universities to provide personal stories on how they learned and what future students should know before and after coming to Taiwan.
9. World Class Education and Why Taiwan is the Ideal Destination for Mongolian Students
10. Comprehensive Introduction of Taiwanese Universities: The book will feature public and private universities introducing degree programs, academic and research accomplishments, student clubs and activities, campus facilities, scholarship opportunities, study abroad and exchange programs and student testimonials.

We expect to have a minimum of 15 universities participating in this project to be able to cover the costs of the project.
